Visit of Pope Francis to the World Meeting of Families

Earlier this week it was confirmed that Pope Francis will visit Dublin for the World Meeting of Families in August. He will attend the Festival of Families in Croke Park on the evening of Saturday 25th, will travel to Knock on Sunday 26th in the morning and will celebrate Mass in the Phoenix Park on Sunday afternoon.

Anyone wishing to go to the Papal Mass in the Phoenix Park will need a ticket. Tickets are free and can only be booked ONLINE at www.worldmeeting2018.ie from June 25th onwards. There will be a bus travelling to Dublin from the parish. We are being told that the journey through the day on the Sunday will be long and will involve significant walks to and from the bus drop-off points. At a minimum, people will have to walk 2½ miles to the Mass and 2½ miles back, but this could be longer depending on where we are located in the park.
