

Adoration Chapel

In consultation with the Adoration Committee, we are delighted to announce the reopening of the Adoration Chapel from **Monday, the 13th of July, 2020**. The opening hours will be from **10am to 10pm, Monday to Saturday**.

In accordance with the current health and safety guidelines, a **maximum of four people**, with 2 metre physical distancing, will be allowed at any one time. In order to provide maximum ventilation, the partition doors between the Adoration Chapel and the main body of the church will remain open at all times.

Daily sanitisation of our churches takes place. However, to provide further assurance, we are inviting people to sanitise the kneeler and chair they have used (disposable sanitising wipes will be provided). Health and Safety guidelines recommend the use of face masks.

If parishioners are uncomfortable using the Adoration Chapel during the week, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the main body of St. Conleth's Church following 12.30pm Mass on Sundays, finishing at 6.45pm (before the 7pm evening Mass).

We invite the "Adorers" to contact a member of the Adoration Committee if they wish to be included on the weekly rota.

It is a source of great joy that this important ministry of prayer in our Adoration Chapel is resuming. I thank the Adoration Committee for their effort and commitment. I pray God's blessing upon all who give of their time in order for this ministry to continue in our Parish.
